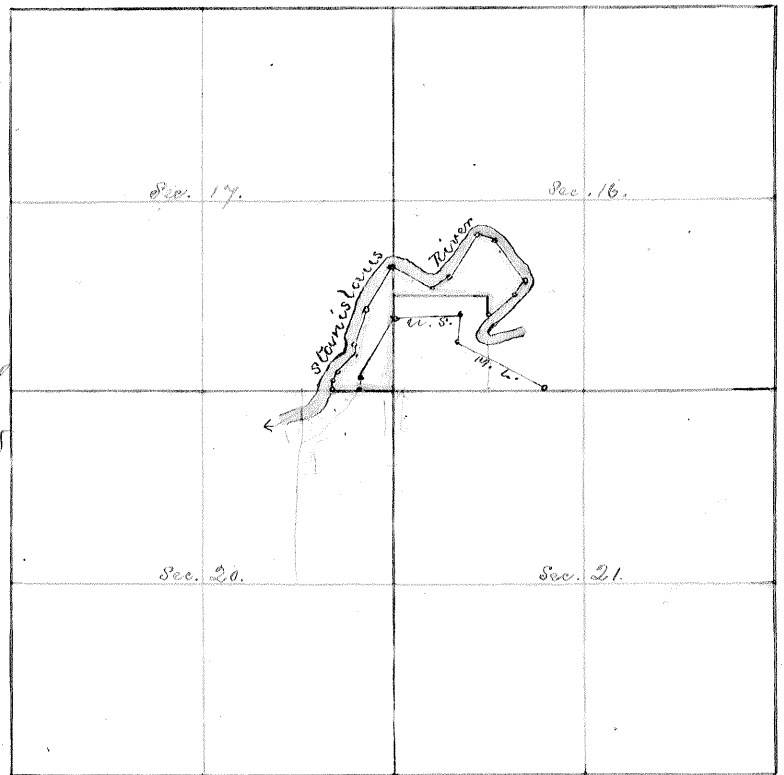

Beginning at the intersection of the East and West line between Sections 17. and 20. Township 2 South, Range 9 East, Base and Meridian of Mt. Diablo, with the left bank of the Stanislaus River; Thence West 13.79 chains to the corner of Sections 16. 17. 20. and 21. Thence North 20.00 chs. to a Post, Thence East 20.00 chs. to a Post; Thence South 3.39 chs. to the left bank of the Stanislaus River; Thence meander down Stream; N $58\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E 7.00 chs; N $35\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E 4.00 chs; N 36° W 12.00 chs; N 84° W 5.00 chs; S $26\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W 13.00 chs; S 61° W 3.00 chs; N 61° W 10.00 chs; S 30° W 9.50 chs; S 23° W 8.00 chs; South 2.00 chs; S 48° W 6.00 chs; S 15° W 2.00 chs; S 1° W 2.00 chs. to the point of beginning;

Run by the true Meridian: Magnetic Variation $15^{\circ} 30'$ East.
