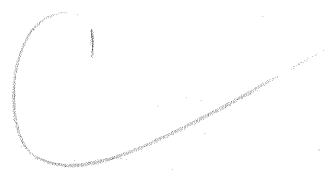

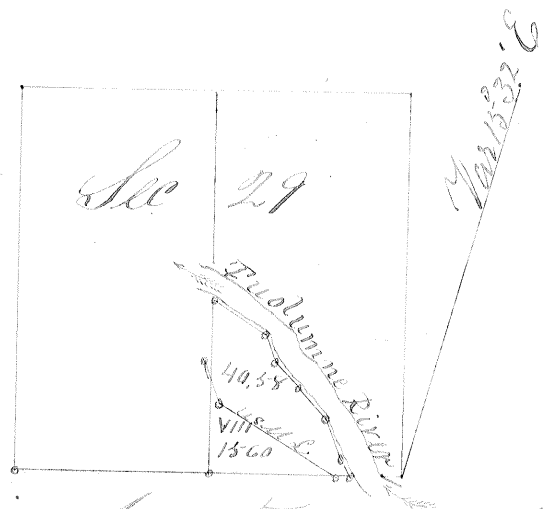
Beginning at a quarter post on line between

meandered down stream, first $N 34^{\circ} 11' W 4.27$ chs,
thence $N 21^{\circ} 58' W 8.30$ chs, thence $N 39^{\circ} 30' W 9.45$ chs,
thence $N 49^{\circ} 30' W 7.43$ chs, thence $N 18^{\circ} 30' W 6$ chs,
and thence $S 36.25$ to place of beginning, containing
56.18 Acres of Land, being Fraction 8 and continuation
of said fraction in Section 29, Township 3 South, Range
12 East.
