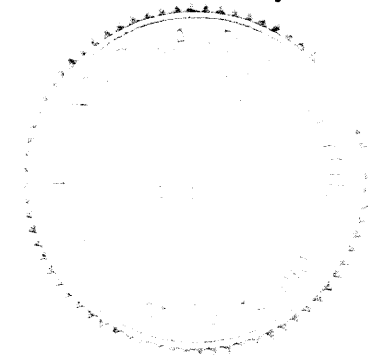


SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

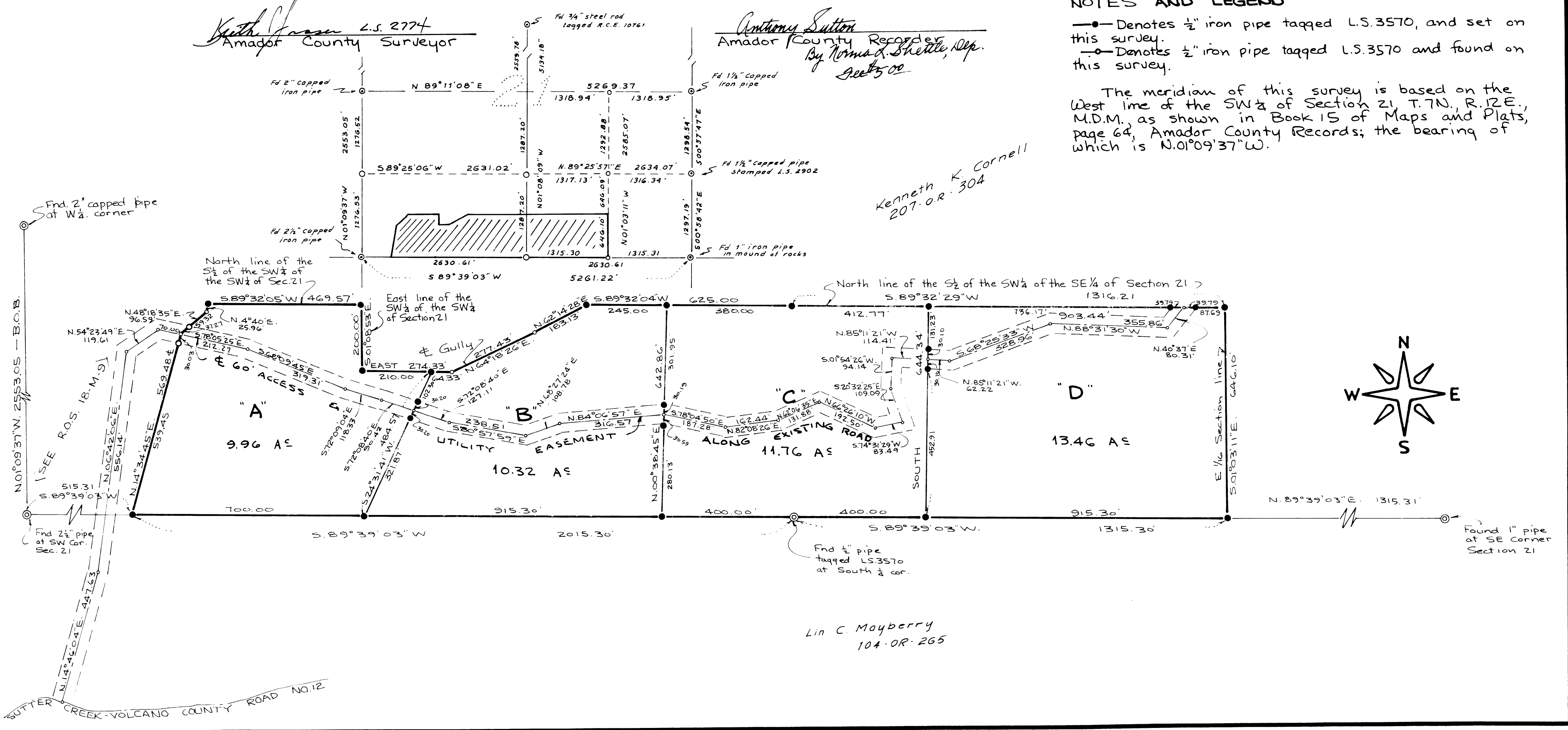
