

**Uninhabited Subspecialty vacant Slots (Post-IMM) for General Medicine (Inductees of January 2023) and General Surgery Residents (Inductees of January 2023 & Jan 2024)**

The sub-specialty induction for session January 2025 is completed and the following slots in uninhabited specialties are left vacant. As per PGMI policy, the regular Postgraduate Residents (**on PGMI Payroll**) who have completed two years Pre-IMM training as General Medicine and General Surgery Residents (4 years program) (**inductees of January 2023**) now want to join uninhabited sub-specialties **OR** who have completed one year Pre-IMM training as General Surgery Resident (**Inductees of January 2024**) and now want to join uninhabited sub-specialty (Neurosurgery) for Post-IMM training with PGMI are allowed to opt these uninhabited sub-specialties slot after changing their specialty if they are interested.

This will be the responsibility of Postgraduate Residents to change the specialty by CPSP and if any problem occurs in this process, PGMI will not be responsible for it. It will be mandatory to take NOC from present Supervisor & Associate Dean/Head of Institute before coming for Interview.

**It should not be possible to reclaim your General Medicine/General Surgery slot if CPSP refuse to change your specialty. The training of PGR concerned will be considered terminated from PGMI & he/she will appear in PGMI induction process if he/she wants to join PGMI again in General Medicine/General Surgery or any other specialty.**

The stipend will be stopped on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2024 on completion of 24 months (Inductees of January 2023) or 12 months (Inductees of January 2024) in General Medicine/General Surgery training and will start from the date of arrival in new Specialty upon issue of RTMC by CPSP.

In case applicants are more than the available slot, merit based selection will be made. Any penalty imposed by CPSP for this change will be responsibility of the resident.

**PROCEDURE & SCHEDULE:** All interested residents are directed to come in person to **PGMI at 10am on Monday 13.01.2025**. On arrival please report to Mr. Shah Fahad at Conference Room near Library. Late arrivals will not be entertained. Vacant slots will be allotted on merit amongst present eligible General Medicine/General Surgery applicants [inductees of January 2023 (Gen. Medicine/Gen. Surgery) & January 2024 (Gen. Surgery)]. If someone is unable to come in person can appear through representative. The representative must bring authority letter and his/her own CNIC. There will be no option of surrender the slot once allotted. The following slots are available at the moment.

**Note:-**

The inclusion of Plastic Surgery in Uninhabited Specialties is one time process & only for this session i.e. January 2025, duly approved by the Executive Council of PGMI in its 50<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 03.01.2025.
