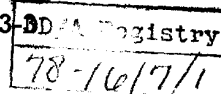

At a recent DDO staff meeting [REDACTED]
C/IMS, suggested that subject film, shown on NBC on
28 March 1978 and [REDACTED]

to be shown to DO case officer trainees and also to their
wives if at all possible. I agree with this suggestion
and recommend that you contact the Pictorial Services
Branch of the Office of Central Reference, where I
understand a copy of the tape is available. The film
should be presented in a seminar-type situation permitting
senior officers and, if at all possible their wives, to
add perspective to the remarks by [REDACTED] and to place
them in a proper overall context. Balanced comments are
very definitely called for regarding the moral issues and
frustrations which case officers and their wives must
resolve. It also would provide a useful introduction to
the supporting roles which wives play.
